PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Mega Bond is a hard set acrylic polymer water based adhesive.

It is Solvent Free, Low Odour, Low VOC, Green Tag certified.

Mega-bond is formulated for the installation of Karndeans range of vinyl planks and vinyl tiles. Megabond can withstand normal wet cleaning practices and may also be used to install other ranges of PVC backed vinyl and vinyl planks.

SURFACE PREPARATION:

To be in accordance with the current Australian Standard "Floor Coverings - 1884-2021 Resilient Sheet & Tiles - Laying & Maintenance Practices" or Australian Standard 2455.2.2019 "Textile Floor Coverings - Installation Practice".

All surfaces to be bonded shall be absorbent, dry, smooth, sound and clean.

Subfloors must also be free of wax, grease, paint, previously used adhesive, polish, PVC based membranes, curing compounds, hydrostatic pressure and any other impurities that may affect adhesion. The minimum subfloor temperature before commencing surface preparation and adhesive application is 10°C. Mega Bond can be applied to concrete substrates with moisture contents up to 85% relative humidity tested with the In-Situ Probe method.

Mega Bond can be applied to concrete substrates with pH readings up to 10.0.

Test all concrete substrate flooring for moisture content, according to the current Australian Standards prior to priming or the installation of any floorcoverings.

APPLICATION:

For the application of vinyl planks and vinyl tiles it is recommended adhesive to be spread with a 1.6mm x 1.6mm 'V1" notched trowel giving a spread rate up to 5 square metres per litre. Apply only the amount of adhesive that can be covered within the open time, before lowering the floorcoverings into the WET Film of adhesive and roll to ensure transfer has occurred. Open time will depend upon atmospheric conditions and substrate absorbency.

Complete installation according to Karndean installation instructions, ensuring the Floorcoverings are rolled with the recommended 45kg roller in both directions, prior to the adhesive setting.

The greater the transfer, the better the adhesive bond. Do not allow heavy traffic for 24 hours.

SPREAD RATE:

Coverage when applying adhesive with a 1.6mm x 1.6mm (V1) notched trowel will achieve up to 5 square metres per litre.

CLEAN UP:

Clean tools immediately after use with warm soapy water. Dried adhesive may be cleaned off using R550 Latex/Acrylic Adhesive Remover applied to a damp cloth then rubbed gently over the dried adhesive or alternatively please use RLA Handy Wipes.

CONTAINER SIZES

15, 10, 1lt litre containers

SHELF LIFE / STORAGE:

12 months in unopened containers stored out of direct sunlight.

Keep in well ventilated areas stored out of direct sunlight.

NOTES & PRECAUTIONS:

- Don't allow the adhesive to skin over or dry out, it is important the floorcovering being bonded is installed into the Wet film of adhesive
- Don't apply adhesive in direct sunlight.
- For Internal use only
